

**MINUTES OF THE 8th MEETING OF THE U.M.T.A. HELD ON 4-4-2013 AT 11.00 AM
IN THE CHAMBERS OF CHIEF SECRETARY TO GOVT., & CHAIRMAN, UMTA.**

- I. The Chief Secretary to Government chaired the meeting. The list of the Members and special invitees present in the meeting is annexed.
- II. The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA & Member Convener, UMTA welcomed the Chairman and Members and introduced the new members of UMTA, Sri. C.S.R.K. Prasad, Head of the Dept. Transportation Division, NIT Warangal and Sri. P. Radha Krishna Murthy, Chief of Transportation and Communication Division, MMRDA, who are appointed and nominated as Expert Members of UMTA by the Government.
- III. The minutes of the 7th UMTA meeting held on 20-4-2012 was readout by the Convener and were confirmed.
- IV. The Action taken report of the 7th UMTA meeting was also reviewed.
- V. **Agenda Items of 8th U.M.T.A.**

Item No.1: Unified Ticket MMTS - APSRTC – HMR

The VC&MD of APSRTC explained to the Committee that, the Combi-Ticket was introduced in 2007 as a common ticket between RTC and MMTS for the convenience of the commuters, with an understanding to share the revenue from the Combi-Ticket of Rs. 400/- per month, on 50:50 basis between RTC and SCR. Since then, there is no increase in the MMTS fares of Railways, whereas, RTC has revised its fares several times and presently the Combi-Ticket fare is Rs.700/- per month. The Railways are retaining 50% of the Combi-ticket tariff on 50:50 sharing basis even on the enhanced tariff of Combi-Tickets thereby causing loss to APSRTC. The MD, APSRTC, requested to direct the Railways to retain only Rs. 200/- towards the cost of the Monthly Railway pass instead of retaining 50% share on each Combi-Ticket.

The MD, APSRRTC informed that, generally the common ticketing system as observed in the other major countries is being shared based on the principles individual transit systems fare, length of travel on individual system and the revenue collection and clearance are handed by independent agency. Further, the MD HMRL explained that, an SPV was initially proposed for MMTS project between the State Govt. and railway and also the Railways have already agreed on this and State Govt., needs to take this issued forward. Presently, the file pertaining to this subject is dealt by Prl. Secretary T, R&B in this regard.

The Chairman after due deliberations, requested the Prl. Secretary MA&UD to take up the matter and expedite the action necessary and to place in the Cabinet for approval.

Further, the Chairman suggested the MD, HMRL to initiate actions to have a common ticket of Metro- MMTS-Bus, so as to have a Unified Public Transport Ticket when the metro start functioning.

Item No. 2: HMDA – Progress of ITS in Hyderabad

The Project Director, HGCL has apprised the Members on the status of the Toll Management System and informed that the Tenders on this could not be finalized due to court case and regarding Highway Traffic Management System the Bid document was sent to JICA for concurrence and the tender documents will be issued to Pre-Qualified Bidders as soon as the Concurrence is received from JICA.

The Metropolitan Commissioner has apprised the Members on the status of City ITS and informed that the specifications and documents have to be placed in the TAC for discussions and the tenders will be called by June 2013.

The Commissioner GHMC and DCP Traffic Hyderabad have informed the members regarding the status of H-TRIMS taken up by the GHMC stating that out of 221 junctions, at 44 junctions the modern signals were erected and commissioned. The Commissioner, GHMC has brought to the notice of the Committee that Rs. 66 Crores was sanctioned by the Government for this project and requested to release the funds.

In this regard, the Chairman requested the Prl. Secretary MA&UD, to bring the matter to the notice of the Finance department and expedite.

On the suggestion of the Sri. C.S.R.K. Prasad, Expert Member, HOD of Transport Division, NIT Warangal and Commissioner, GHMC the Chairman suggested Commissioner, HMDA to study the institutional arrangement for City ITS and for integration of ITS at city level as it involves multi disciplinary experts.

The Committee has suggested the APSRTC, HMRL and MMTS to establish their ITS centers which will be integrated with the City ITS along with the H-TRIMS.

Item No. 3: HMDA – Railway Passenger and Freight Terminals

The Metropolitan Commissioner has apprised the Members regarding the earmaking of land for passenger and freight terminals around Hyderabad and Secunderabad in the recently notified MDP-2031, after discussions with the SCR officials. Further the MC brought to the notice of the Chairman that as per the zoning and development promotion regulations of MDP-2031, the Railway authorities have to initiate the process of acquisition of land, technical feasibility and designs within 3 years from the date of notification. The Committee requested the Railway officials to expedite the process.

Item No. 4: APSRTC – Request for allotment of Lands for construction of Bus Depots & Bus Stations

The VC & MD APSRTC informed the proposals of RTC of constructing new Bus Depots at 11 locations and new Bus Stations at 20 locations, in HMA. The Chairman has requested the VC&MD APSRTC to address the same to the Transport department with full justification of land requirement which will be forwarded to Collector to initiate the process of alienation.

Item No. 5: APSRTC – Provision for Bus Bays & Bus Shelters on Radial Roads Connecting Outer Ring Road

On the request of the VC & MD APSRTC for provision of Bus Bays & Bus Shelters on Radial Roads Connecting Outer Ring Road, the MC, HMDA agreed to examine the same with HGCL.

Item No. 6: HMDA – Integrated Commuter Terminal Complex, Secunderabad

The MD HMRL has informed that, the transferring of land to HMRL is in process, and duly taking inputs from SCR, APSRTC, Traffic Police Dept, GHMC, HMDA and other departments concerned, will develop the Integrated Commuter Terminal Complex at Secunderabad, in Old Gandhi Hospital premises.

Item No. 7: HMRL – Progress of Hyderabad Metro Rail

The MD HMRL has briefed the committee the progress of the Metro Rail Project.

Item No. 8: HMDA – Transit Orient Development (TOD)

The MC, HMDA explained the need for carrying out Transit Orient Development (TOD) Studies in HMA. The Committee approved the proposals of carrying out the TOD study in HMA.

Item No. 9: HMDA – Comprehensive Transportation Study for Hyderabad Metropolitan Area.

The Consultants of CTS, M/s LEA Associates has made a detailed presentation regarding Long Term Transport Strategy for the year 2041 for HMA.

Considering the population projection, Employment forecast, land-use scenarios, network scenarios and vehicle growth scenarios for 2041, suggested a desirable transport systems such as Metro network of 235 Kms (including phase I corridors), BRT network of 115 Kms, MMTS network of 150 Kms (phase I &II) and an hierarchical road network of 6500 Kms in HMA.

The preliminary estimates of transportation proposals works out to Rs. 1,46,530 crores i.e. average Rs. 5000 crores per annum needed for next 30 years to meet present deficiencies and to meet future demands.

The Committee suggested forming a Resource Mobilization Task Force with senior level officers of concerned departments for raising resources.

On request of the MC, HMDA, the stake holders GHMC, APSRTC & HMRL have agreed to release the remaining balance amount of their share for CTS.

Item No.10 : HMDA - Traffic Impact Assessment Guidelines.

The Committee approved to develop Traffic Impact Assessment (TIA) guidelines for HMA using the services of CTS consultants who are already developing the Urban Transport Planning Model. The proposals of the Consultants on the additional services that are to be carried out for the TIA study shall be examined and will be placed in the next meeting of the UMTA for approval

Item No.11: HMDA – Non-Motorised Transport (NMT) policy for HMA

The committee agreed for promoting NMT usage and to formulate NMT policies and also agreed for constituting a working group comprising of HMDA, GHMC, Traffic Police, HMWS&SB and APCPDCL for finalizing the NMT policy in HMA and also to identify specific projects for implementation.

Item No.12: HMDA – Parking Policy for HMA.

The committee agreed for a need to have a parking policy in HMA as a demand management measure and to promote public transport systems and also to form a working group comprising of HMDA, GHMC & Traffic Police to interact with the CTS team and finalise the parking policy, and to identify specific projects for implementation.

Item No.13 : Urban Transport Fund

The Committee suggested the Task Force proposed in Item No. 9, also to examine this aspect.

Item No. 14 : Other items

Since many issues were related to finance, the Chairman suggested to include the Prl. Secretary Finance as a member of UMTA.
