Sub:-Mines and Quarries - Payment of Environment Impact Fee (EIF) by Hard builders @ Rs.3/- per Sq. Ft. for build-up area above 10000 for the approved building plan by the competent authority- building plans approved from the period of notification to the same guidelines on EIF - Further instructions - Issued - Reg.

I invite kind attention to the reference 1st cited wherein the Govt. basing on representations from Telangana Real Estate Developers Association (TREDA), Confederation of Real Estate Developers Association (CREDAI) and proposals from the Director of Mines & Geology, Hyderabad issued orders stipulating that the Local Panchayat, Municipal Bodies, Urban Development Authorities and other authorities competent to approve building plans shall collect Environment Impact Fee (EIF) @Rs.3/- per Sq. Ft. for buildings with an area of more than 10000 Sq. Ft. of built-up area while sanctioning building plans to account for any building or construction material that may have escaped levy of seigniorage fee at source and the amount being remitted into treasury.

2. Further, through the reference 2nd cited, in partial modification of the orders issued earlier the Government issued necessary instructions as guidelines on payment of EIF:

The payment of Environment Impact Fee (EIF) shall cover the entire built-up area including the area meant for parking and other allied services.

- ii. The building plan approval authority in the Local Panchayat, Municipal Bodies, Urban Development Authorities and other authorities shall issue a certificate on payment of Environment Impact Fee (EIF) by the builder.
- iii. The EIF is also payable by the builders on voluntary disclosure on the strength of the certificate issued by the licensed engineers by the Government regarding the extent of built-up area.
- 3. Further, basing on the proposals of the Director of Mines & Geology vide reference 3rd cited, the Government vide reference 4th cited issued further guidelines on payment of EIF by the builders for the ongoing construction ventures and just completed buildings (copy enclosed for reference).
- 4. In this connection, the particulars of Head of Account and the DDO code for payment of Environment Impact Fee (EIF) by the builders is as follows:

5. Further, the original challan towards payment of Environment Impact Fee (EIF) furnished by the builder may be forwarded by the competent authority in the Local Panchayat, Municipal Bodies, Urban Development Authorities and other authorities to the Assistant Director of Mines & Geology concerned for the purpose of reconciliation and submission of information to the Director of Mines & Geology, who in turn will submit report to the Government in the matter.

- 6. In this connection, after the approval of building plan by the competent authority and payment of Environment Impact Fee (EIF), if there is any deviation by the builder in the construction and when it is subjected to regularization by the competent authority, in such a case the differential Environment Impact Fee (EIF) shall be collected from the builder and transmitted to the Assistant Director of Mines & Geology concerned.
- 7. In view of the above, suitable instructions may be issued to the competent authority in the Local Panchayat, Municipal Bodies, Urban Development Authorities and other authorities for effective implementation of the orders issued by the Government.
